

Mother's Day Similes Using As

Your mother is so special. Let's make similes about her! Remember that similes are comparisons using the words "like" or "as." The first half of an "as" simile is usually a noun with an adjective. In our similes, "mother" is the noun and it is followed by an adjective, such as "sweet" or "calm." The last half of a simile is comparing the original noun to another noun. Look at the examples of similes using the word "as," then create your own! Use the Adjective Ideas and Noun Ideas boxes to help you.

Examples:

Noun **adjective** **Noun**

My **mother** is as **sweet** as powdered **sugar** on a pretty cookie.

My mom is as calm as the ocean on a still day.

My mother is as generous as a mother bird feeding her young.

My mom is as smart as a computer.
