Ans: Lorenzo and his friends plan to disguise themselves at dinner time since they were organizing a masquerade for Bassanio's dinner party. During Elizabethan times the masque was an amateur dramatic practice usually performed in private houses. The players wore masks and costumes and took part in a torch procession, playing musical instruments. They were not fully prepared for the disguise.         2.       Who is supposed to be the torch-bearer? What is the actual purpose of having a torch-bearer in the scene?         Ans: Jessica, disguised as a boy, is supposed to be the torch-bearer. The actual purpose of having a torch-bearer in the scene is to facilitate the elopement of Jessica with Lorenzo.         3.       Whose letter does Lancelot bring? Why is it an important confidential letter? How does Lorenzo guess whose letter it is?         Ans: Launcelot brings the letter of Jessica? It is an important confidential letter as it contained Jessica's plan to elope with Lorenzo. On receiving the letter Lorenzo guesses whose letter it is after looking at the handwriting. He declares that the handwriting is familiar to him and the letter is written by a lovely, fair and beautiful hand.         4.       Who is giving the dinner party?
